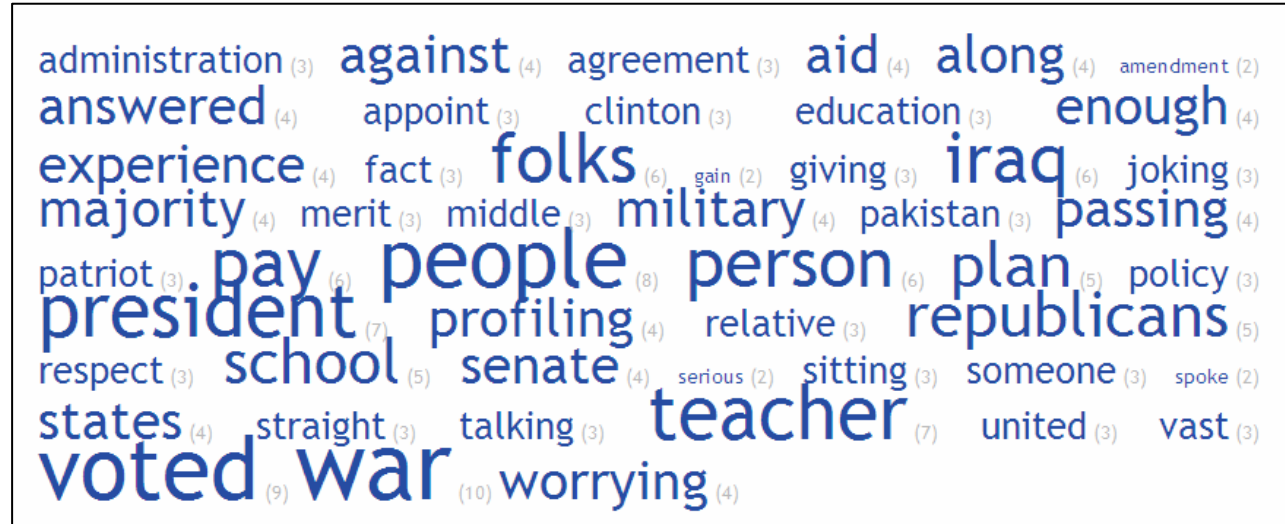

Visual representation of each 2008 Democratic presidential candidate's answers given during Thursday evening's debate in Las Vegas.

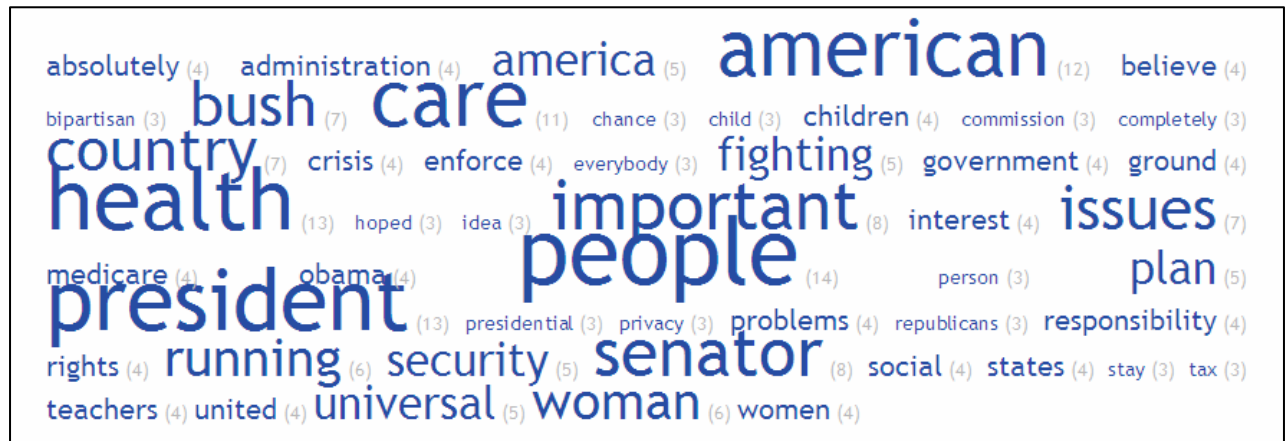
Senator Joe Biden (D-DE)

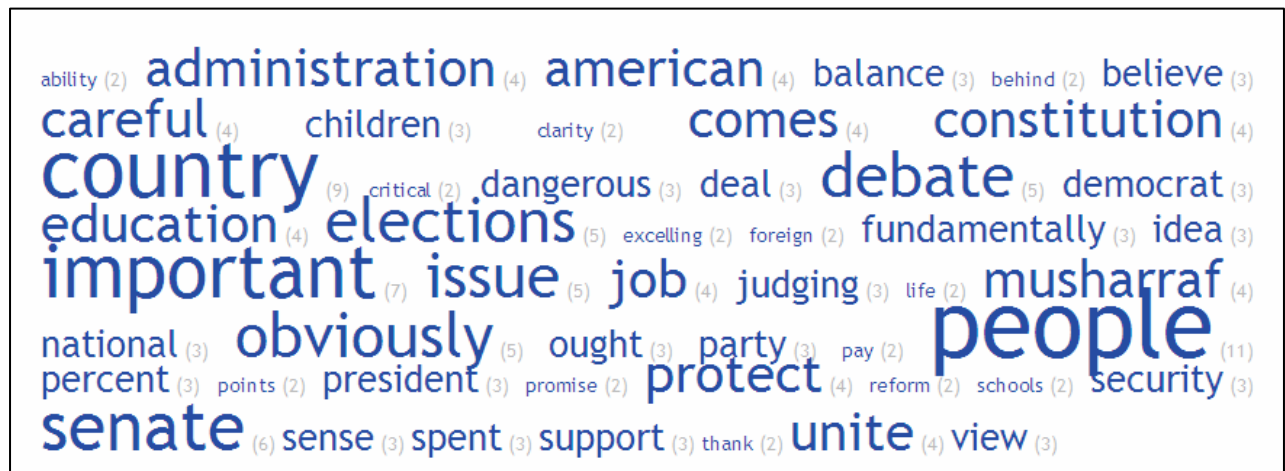

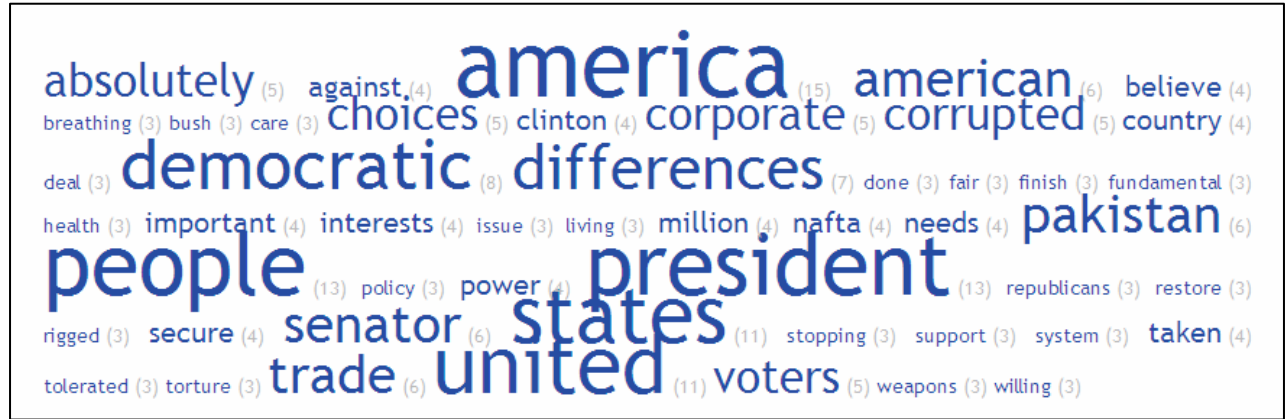

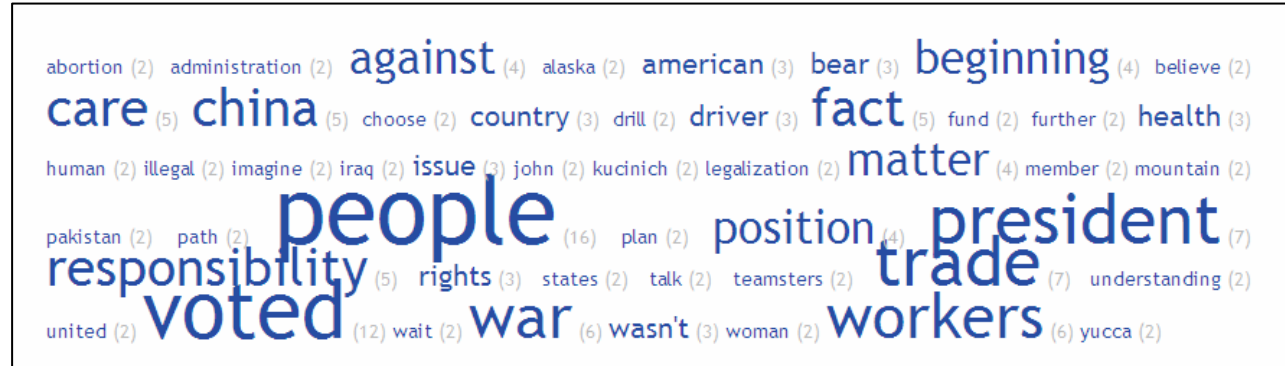

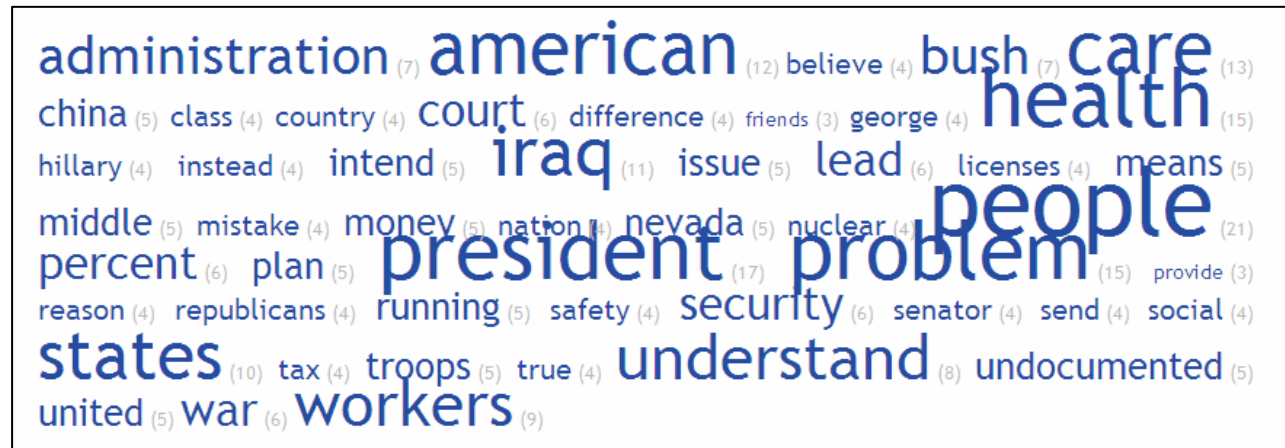

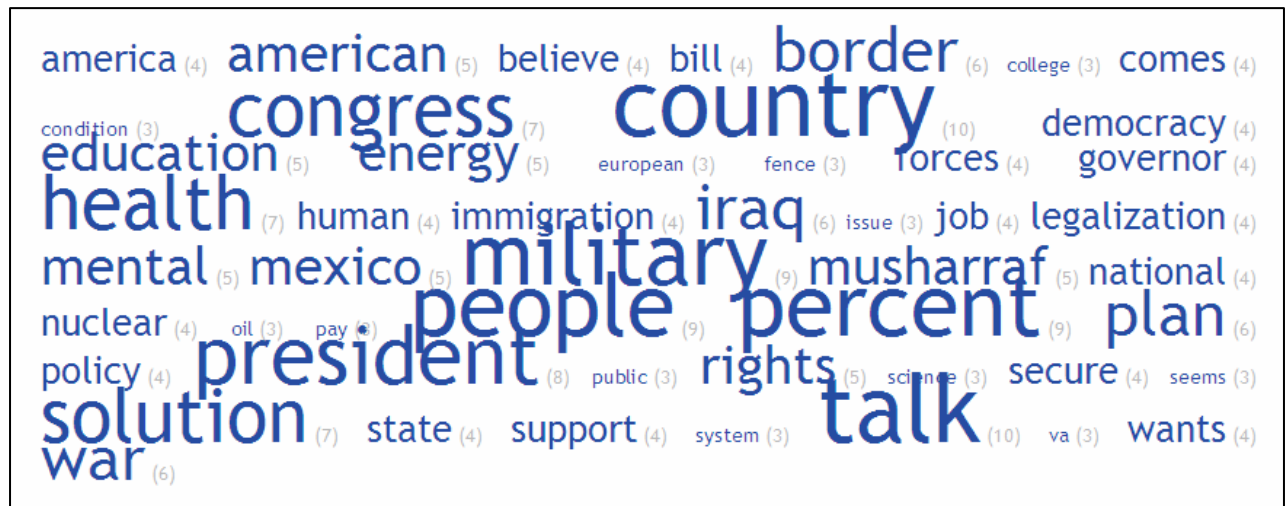
